

Town of Pepin January 20, 2026, Board meeting minutes

REGULAR MONTHLY BOARD MEETING CALLED TO ORDER ON January 20, 2026, BY KEVIN KOSOK AT 6:52 p.m

- Roll Call: Kevin Kosok, Dale Kircher, Gary Samuelson, and Dennis Wolfe were present. Also present: Nancy Wolfe, Treasurer and Deb Seifert, Clerk. Absent: Mike Cedarblade
- Approve Minutes – The December minutes were sent and read prior to the meeting via email. Motion was made to approve the December minutes by Dale and seconded by Dennis. All were in favor.
- Treasurers report: Nancy presented the Treasurer's report: General Account \$79,072.25, Tax Account \$441,192.87, Savings Account \$5,681.25, Real Estate Money Market \$186,396.64.

NEW BUSINESS

- Kevin Anderson, Fire Chief from the Lund Fire Department gave an update on elected and appointed personnel for the current year. They currently have 24 fire fighters on their roster. There were 56 calls out in 2025.
- Road Updates/Maintenance – Nothing to report

- Pepin County Highway Updates: Comment was made that County Road CC in our Township was icy and not as clear as it was in Pierce County. Kevin stated that there are new guys maintaining the roads so as they improve, so should the roads.

- Citizens Concern – Jon gave a quick summary as to where the lawsuit is standing. An investigator will be assigned to follow up.

- Several suggestions were made to get roads black topped this year. Kevin said that it would be reviewed on the annual road inspection.
