REGULAR TOWN OF PEPIN BOARD MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY KEVIN KOSOK ON OCTOBER 18,2022

- Roll Call-Kevin Kosok, Dale Kircher, Gary Samuelson, Dennis Wolfe present. Joe Komisar absent.
- Approve Minutes -Dennis Wolfe made a motion to approve the minutes seconded by Gary Samuelson all were in favor.
- Treasurers Report-Dennis Wolfe made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report General account balance \$9,796.02, Tax account \$130,214.24, Covid Account \$67,789.95

### **NEW BUSINESS**

- Temporary Class B Liquor license YMCA camp-Matt and Chante were present to answer questions about the fund raiser for the YMCA camp. Dennis Wolfe made a motion to approve to issue a temporary class B license for the fund raiser on November 11-13, 2022 seconded by Gary Samuelson all were in favor.
- 2023 Budget – The board has concerns about the ambulance budget. How can they raise the on call time from a \$1.00- \$5.00 without a vote from the municipalities? The Board would like Nancy Wolfe to write a letter to Pepin Ambulance about the concerns.  
Discussion was held about the other items on the proposed budget. The Public hearing on the proposed budget date is set for November 14,2022 at 6:45
- Road Updates/maintenance-No more rock project for the year. Kevin Kosok would like a new item on the agenda each month-Pepin County Highway Concerns. 50/50 project-nothing has been done.  
Bids on rock- Milestone prepay 7.78 per ton 20,000 ton \$155,500.00  
Dennis Wolfe made a motion to prepay Milestone for rock seconded by Gary Samuelson all were in favor. Kevin Kosok will be in communication with Milestone on 2 payments one in December and January.
